AN ACT to amend the Stem Cell Research and Therapy Act, 2019 No. 11 of 2019. **ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Stem Cell Research and Therapy (Amendment) Bill 2020

2. Interpretation

In this Act—

"principal Act" means the Stem Cell Research and Therapy Act 2019 No. 11 of 2020

3. Amendment of section 4 – Establishment of the Stem Cell Oversight Committee Section 4 of the principal Act is amended –

Stem Cell Research and Therapy (*Amendment*) *Act*, 2020.

(a) in subsection (1) by repealing the word "five" and replacing it with the word "seven"; and

(b) in subsection (7) by repealing the word "Four" and replacing it with the word "Five"

4. Amendment of section 5 – Functions of the National Stem Cell Oversight Committee

Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by relettering the current paragraph (h) as paragraph (i) and by inserting immediately after paragraph (g) a new paragraph (h) as follows –

"(*h*) issue guidelines;"
